

Don Walker Scholarship Program Details

The Don Walker Scholarship Program provides a benefit for eligible children of Magna employees who are entering their first year of an undergraduate degree or certificate program in STEM-related fields of study primarily focused on mobility and the automotive manufacturing process.

To Qualify

- The student's parent or legal guardian must be a full-time Magna employee with a minimum of three (3) consecutive years of service, as of July 10th of the application year.
- The student must be between the ages of 17-25 and be a dependent of the full-time Magna employee.
- The student must be entering their first year of a qualifying undergraduate degree, diploma or certificate program.
- The student must have a minimum of a B- (70%) average. Please attach official transcripts displaying at least six (6) final marks at the Grade 12 level.

What is a Qualifying Program?

Interested students must be entering their first year of a qualifying program. Eligible programs include those in which a degree, diploma or certification is achieved in a STEM or technical area of study, with a direct application to Magna's automotive manufacturing process such as:

- Automotive Designer
- Automotive Engineering
 Technician
- Automotive Related
 Engineering
- CAD/CAM Operators
- CNC specialists

- Controls Technician
- Machinist
- Mould Maker
- Plastics Specialist
- PLC Specialist
- Robotics
- Tool & Die

Selection and Award

Each year, up to 80 recipients globally will be selected by the Don Walker Scholarship Committee. Recipients will be selected based on academic performance, extra-curricular involvement and achievements, as well as contributions to the community.

Each scholarship recipient will receive an initial award of \$3,000 with the option to re-apply annually, provided the student meets the renewal requirements outlined within. Scholarships are renewable for up to four (4) consecutive years for a total of \$12,000.



Scholarship Renewal Requirements

Scholarship awards may be renewed annually for up to 4 consecutive years.

To renew the scholarship award, recipients must:

- Provide an original official transcript of marks from the previous academic year, identifying a minimum B- (70%) average. The Don Walker Scholarship Program Committee reserves the right to rescind a scholarship if the final admission average falls below the required average. Please note, scanned copies of the transcript are not accepted.
- 2. Complete the Scholarship Renewal Form.

Co-Op Work Term / International Studies

Scholarship funds may be suspended when a student is enrolled in either a co-op work term, an exchange program or is studying overseas. Scholarship funds will resume once the student has returned to their full-time academic studies in their assigned program and has notified the Scholarship Coordinator.

Submission of Application

The Don Walker Scholarship Program Coordinator should receive the application package no later than **July 10th**, **2023**.
