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Proper delivery of pyrotechnic goods

To whom it may concern,

With this letter we would like to inform you about the proper delivery of pyrotechnic test components. To avoid delays or problems in the future, pyrotechnic goods must be packed, labeled, and transported in accordance with ADR regulations. Otherwise we are not permitted to accept the incoming goods.

As **sender**, you are obliged in accordance with **ADR 1.4.2.1.1 (b)** to provide the **carrier** with the necessary transport and accompanying documents for a shipment. According to **ADR 1.4.2.3.1**, as **recipient** we are obliged to check the incoming goods for the ADR regulations that apply to us. This includes the availability of the required **transport papers**:

- **delivery note**
- **ADR transport papers** for dangerous goods

In case of improper transportation of dangerous goods, **fines** can apply for everyone involved in the transport process. Depending on the classification of the dangerous goods, carriers require separate training.

Please pass this information on to your freight forwarder to avoid misunderstandings during the delivery process.
